



Plein Air Painting Contest
Event: March 4; Registration Deadline, March 3, 2017

On Saturday, March 4, artists are invited to paint an image of the Tropic Cinema, 416 Eaton Street. This site was chosen to complement this year's Birthday Celebration theme of Tennessee Williams as a screenwriter. Following the Williams' pattern of completing a painting in a few hours, the artists will begin painting at 8:30 a.m. and complete their work by 12 noon. A 12"x16" hard canvas will be provided upon arrival at the site and collected at noon. Any medium will be accepted and artists must supply their materials. Pre-registration and payment of a \$20 fee must be submitted by March 3 to the address given on the registration form below. Dr. Cori Convertito, Curator, Key West Art and Historical Society, will coordinate the painting contest and will join three other qualified art community leaders in serving as judges. Artists are asked to choose one of two categories in which to participate: professional artist or recreational artist. The first place winner in each category will be awarded \$200; second place winner \$100. Winners will be honored at the March 26 reception being held at the Tennessee Williams Exhibit, 513 Truman Avenue from 6 to 8 p.m. **SPECIAL NOTE: in cooperation with the Tropic Cinema, all paintings will be exhibited and for sale at the Tropic Cinema Gallery from April 5 until May 14. An opening reception will be held on April 7 from 6 to 7 p. m. Sold art must remain hanging in the Gallery until May 15.**
