REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION DEADLINE: MARCH 7, 2018

All interested writers are invited to submit a short story of 1500 to 4000 words with some minor reference to Tennessee Williams' life in Key West included in the story. Submission is limited to one short story per person. A completed registration form, a registration fee of \$20 for adults and \$10 for students and the completed short story must be postmarked no later than March 7 and sent to the address provided on the registration form provided below. Writer Joanna Schmida will coordinate the writing contest and join two other respected judges of fiction in choosing the winners. They will receive copies of the short stories without authors' names. The first place winner will be awarded \$200 and the second place winner \$100. The winners will be honored and asked to read two pages of their choice from their short story at the March 26, 2018 Birthday Reception from 6 to 8 p.m. at the Tennessee Williams Exhibit, 513 Truman Avenue. **With a sufficient number of outstanding submissions, there is the possibility of publication in an on-line journal.**
